1. Educational Goals for the Course:

- Educators will learn the history, philosophies, and techniques for quality classroom and in-car Driver Education instruction.

2. Instructional Learning Objectives – Educators will:

3. Course Requirements – Educators will:

- Read the Drive Right textbook, current edition.
- Observe a minimum of three classroom lessons taught by a licensed instructor; prepare three reports using provided forms.
- Know the Idaho Statutes that must be complied with when teaching and/or administering a driver education program.
- Use the Idaho Content Standards and Benchmarks to prepare a scope and sequence for 30 hours of classroom instruction.
- Prepare and deliver three classroom lessons or activities to a classroom of Driver Education students.
- Observe a minimum of three in-car lessons led by a certified Driver Education Instructor while seated in the back seat; prepare three reports using the provided forms.
- Use the Idaho Content Standards and Benchmarks to prepare a scope and sequence for six hours of behind the wheel instruction; to include local driving routes that support the goals for each drive.
- Schedule and complete an Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) road test administered by a certified ITD tester.
- Know the laws that pertain to driving in Idaho.
- Successfully complete the final exam with a score of at least an 80%.
- Successfully complete all coursework and exams with a score of at least an 80%.

4. Course Meeting Dates, Times and Location:

(A minimum of 15 contact hours, plus additional outside work, required per credit earned.)

This is an online class to meet the requirements of a four-semester credit course as outlined above. September 1 - December 31, 2011. Classes will be offered three times a year as an online Angel course. Educators will receive e-mail messages with login information and course due dates within the first few days of class. - ### 5. Due Date for Completion of Course Requirements:
- December 31, 2011. Unit assignments are due every two weeks. Late work is 50% off, and all course work is due on or before the last day of class (Mentoring/student teaching assignments may take longer depending on available programs to observe and work with). The Pass/Fail grade designation is based on passing classroom grade (80%) and a score of at least 80% on the final exam.
