#### **Nurse Practitioner, St. Alphonsus Regional Medical Center Boise Idaho** Dec 2017-present

- I have worked in internal medicine and for cardiology. Caring for inpatients in a hospital setting managing their internal medicine issues during the perioperative period. This job involves risk stratification and workup prior to surgery as an outpatient, as well as inpatient medical management. Starting in Sept 2019, I transitioned to only cardiology mostly inpatient. In this setting the diagnoses primarily seen include coronary artery disease, atrial fibrillation, CHF, arrhythmia management.

#### **Nurse Practitioner, St. Luke's Idaho Cardiology**

March 2013-April 2018

- Caring for patients in a cardiology practice. In this practice setting I have had experiences managing patients with hypertension, CHF, coronary artery disease, atrial fibrillation, and other chronic diseases. I have also served as a preceptor for students both in the clinic and the hospital setting. I have mostly worked in the rural clinics including Fruitland and Caldwell. I enjoy serving the underserved rural populations. I have travelled to satellite clinics in Baker, Oregon as well.

#### **Nurse Practitioner, West Valley Medical Center Rural Clinic** December, 2010-March 2013

- Caring for patients in a family practice. This is a practice with quite a few internal medicine type patients, so I have had experience managing hypertension, diabetes, CHF, COPD and other lung diseases, renal disease and other chronic illnesses. I worked in the rural clinics caring for mostly underserved population in New Plymouth, Wilder, Parma.

#### **Assistant Professor and adjunct professor, Northwest Nazarene University** August, 2011-Current

- Job responsibilities include teaching and developing several topics within the nursing program, both online and in class, and coordinating clinical rotations for students within these courses. I have utilized simulation throughout the courses as well, incorporating a systems approach to education and continuously evaluating all relevant factors to improve the delivery of education.

I functioned as a charge nurse and bedside nurse. Several specific skills obtained while working in this area include caring for patients receiving IABP therapy and CRRT therapy. I also served on several committees during this time including a policy development committee and care plan committee.

June 2002-July 2005: Saint Alphonsus Regional Medical Center; Boise, Idaho

- Job responsibilities included caring for patients with complex medical needs on a telemetry and step-down unit. I functioned as a charge and bedside nurse in this area. Common diagnosis' seen on this unit were varied and include patients with CVA, MI, traumas, PE, Acute and Chronic Renal Failure, Sepsis, COPD, and CHF. One of my duties as a nurse included collecting data about risk factors for coronary artery disease from postoperative open-heart patients. This data was then given to a research team to use in a study about risk factors of CAD and relationship to

post operative outcomes.
