The NNU Bachelor of Science in Engineering (BSE) program is ABET-accredited, provides great industry internships, and has a vibrant faculty and staff. The BSE is a multidisciplinary program focusing on broad engineering fundamentals and liberal arts, and includes a choice of upper-division concentrations in electrical & computer engineering, mechanical engineering, and engineering physics.

## Scholarship Eligibility

To be eligible to apply for this scholarship, you must:

- Apply and be admitted to Northwest Nazarene University as a new full-time student
- Specify Engineering as your intended major
- Submit to NNU an ACT Math score>30 or SAT Math score>670
- Participate in a face-to-face interview with Engineering faculty on campus
- Demonstrate financial need via FAFSA
